

CUNA Technology Council  Awards
Frequently Asked Questions

- ◆ Is an award given in each category?
 - *Yes, awards will be given in each category. However, if the quality of entries in a given category is not strong enough, no awards will be given in that category.*
- ◆ What is the maximum number of awards that can be given per category?
 - *Depending on the strength of the entries, more than one award can be given in each category.*
- ◆ How are the judges chosen?
 - *Judges are selected based on their experience and involvement in the credit union system. A panel of Technology Council Communication Committee members, past winners, and industry professionals will score each entry.*
- ◆ What criteria will the judges use?
 - *Selection will be based on the entries' strategy, process, application and results. Recipients will be selected without regard to credit union asset size.*
- ◆ Can I enter more than one category?
 - *You can enter more than one category, however, the entries must each be a different entry and not the same entry in multiple categories. The contest administrators will decide if an entry belongs in a different category. You may also submit more than one entry within the same category.*
- ◆ How should I submit my entry?
 - *Please submit your entry form and entry pieces electronically to Council Administration – bbischke@cuna.coop. Once your entry is received and processed, you will receive an email acknowledgement.*
- ◆ Are the non-winners notified after the judging, as well as the winners?
 - *Yes, all entrants are notified of the status of their entry by a date designated on the confirmation email.*
- ◆ Is it necessary for someone from my credit union to attend the conference to accept our award?
 - *Yes, the award recipients will be honored during the membership and recognition lunch taking place at the conference.*
- ◆ Will I be required to make an acceptance speech?
 - *No speeches are required, however, you may take the opportunity to share some brief remarks. You will be asked to stay in the room after the luncheon for photos that will be posted to our web site and sent to trade publications.*
